Ticket sales for the Rundfunkchor Berlin's 26/27 season start on 15 July

Tickets for RundfunkchorLounge, Christmas Concert, »We're Not Going Anywhere – Queer Resilience« and »Flying Mozart«

Ticket sales for the Rundfunkchor Berlin's 26/27 concert season will start on 15 July at 10 am. Under the direction of Chief Conductor Gijs Leenaars, the new season features major choral-symphonic concerts with orchestra as well as signature projects such as the community-programme »We're Not Going Anywhere – Queer Resilience«, a new edition of »Flying Mozart« with the Flying Steps, the traditional Christmas Concert at the Berlin Cathedral and three RundfunkchorLounges at Heimathafen Neukölln.

With »We're Not Going Anywhere – Queer Resilience«, the Rundfunkchor Berlin is bringing to life the winning concept of its ideas competition »Choir of the Future« – a community concert at the Haus des Rundfunks that makes queer realities both visible and audible, combining new repertoire with three queer amateur choirs from Berlin. The staged production »Flying Mozart – Reimagined@Tempodrom« with the urban dance company Flying Steps places Mozart's Requiem on a 270-degree stage and fuses classical choral music with urban dance, electronic elements and visual projections. The Rundfunkchor Berlin also presents its own choral-symphonic concert together with the Sinfonisches Kammerorchester Berlin in the Concert Hall of the Berlin University of the Arts (UdK), featuring Mendelssohn's Psalm 42 and Mozart's Mass in C minor. Further programmes include the traditional Christmas Concert at the Berlin Cathedral, three RundfunkchorLounges at Heimathafen Neukölln, which interweave music and discussion on socially relevant topics, as well as an a cappella concert at the Heilig-Kreuz-Kirche in which the participants of the Schola, the Rundfunkchor Berlin's young artists' programme, present their own programme together with members of the ensemble.

Advance ticket sales for the popular sing-along concert, which will feature Mozart's Requiem at the Philharmonie Berlin in 2027, will begin in autumn 2026. Members of the Friends and Supporters of the Rundfunkchor Berlin will enjoy an exclusive early booking period from 28 September 2026; regular registration will open on 5 October 2026.
